

PSHE

This term we are focusing on New Beginnings and Getting on and falling out which touches on anti-bullying. We will also be taking part in a democratic process to decide who our Champion of Change will be for each class.

Maths

This Term the Maths Topics we are focussing on are:

Place Value: We will continue to develop our knowledge of the value of numbers and how they relate to each other.

Addition and Subtraction: We will develop our understanding of what subtraction and addition are and how to use concrete resources.

Numbers within 20 and 100 which includes working with money.

We will round off the term with multiplication.

English

We will be exploring a range of different text types. These will all be linked to the topic and children will have opportunities to write non-chronological reports and story narratives. We will also be adding in some cross curricular writing with other subjects.

We will be continuing to learn different aspects of grammar with a particular focus on punctuation.

Applying phonics knowledge to writing will be threaded throughout.

PE

Most of our PE sessions will be outside with either Mr Baxter or the class teacher. The children will be learning different skills and learning how to keep fit

RE

This term we will be learning about Christian baptism and christenings. They will also be exploring good deeds through Judaism.

Music

This term we will be focusing on rhythm, pitch and pulse. The children will listen to a range of music and will participate by playing different rhythms. They will start to learn about high and low sounds

Art / Design and Technology

During this term we be focussing on colours and colour mixing in art. In DT our focus is designing, making and evaluating our work whilst thinking about waterproofing and boat building.

Science

Our Science Topics this term are seasonal change, plants and everyday materials.

During the first part of the term we are learning about the seasonal changes and what changes they can see.

We will continue to keep a 'watch' of the seasonal changes but our focus will be plants and then everyday materials after half term.

Topic

During Topic this term we are exploring the 7 continents and 5 oceans. The children will be using atlases, globes and maps to support them in their leaning. They will also be introduced to N S E W. We will also be looking at changes within living memory, using timelines, artefacts and relevant texts.

Computing

This term we will be learning how to stay safe online and what we should do if we see something that makes us feel uncomfortable.
