September 2018 Admissions Evening

End of KSI and KS2 Tests

Last half term was very busy with both our Yr 2 and Yr 6 children taking part in the national tests for 7 and II year olds which are also known as the end of Key Stage tests.

Throughout the whole testing time all the children concerned remained calm and focused on their work.

The results of the KS2 tests will not be released to the school until Tuesday 10 July. Prior to releasing the data staff will need to check the marking as quite often there are anomalies that need verifying with the Standards Agency. We therefore hope to be able to turn the data around to the pupils and parents by Friday 13 July 2018.

Our school has been notified that the assessments undertaken by our Yr 2

children will be moderated during June by members of the Local Authority staff to ensure that our teacher assessments are in line with the expectations nationally. This will delay slightly the release of our KSI results to parents as we will have to wait until the moderation process has taken place and the results been agreed.

Yr I Phonics Screening Check

During the week beginning Monday II June, all of our Yr I pupils will be participating in the national Phonics Screening Check.

The details of how the assessment process will run was outlined to parents at the recent Yr I Phonics Workshops that we held in May.

Art Week – week beginning Monday 21 May

At the end of last half term we held our annual Art Week.

This year our theme was People.

During the week the children had the opportunity to learn about the following artists: LS Lowry, Barbara Hepworth.

On the Thursday they met and worked with Suffolk artist, Kevin Moore.

We all had a great week — learning all about the skills used by the artists and then applying to our own artwork. I'd like to thank the parents who joined us on the Tuesday.

Mrs Sole, our HLTA, did a fabulous job in organising the week and then preparing the teaching resources so that

we could all learn about the different artists covered during the week.

Sun Cream

With the arrival of the warmer weather we would like to take this opportunity to remind parents that we encourage the children to come into school each day with their sun hats (named) and a water bottle.

Sun protection cream should be applied before school. Children are able to bring their own bottle of sun protection cream into school (ensuring that the bottle is clearly named) and this can be re-applied by the child at lunchtime. It's helpful if you can show your child how to apply the sun cream as some of our children are very heavy handed and end up applying nearly a whole bottle in one application.

Please do remind your child that they should not be sharing their sun cream with other children.

School Meals

Many of you may have heard that the contractor the school uses to provide our school meals, CCS Catering will cease trading at the end of the calendar year.

Our school is one of five schools within the WASP Partnership to use CCS Catering for the supply of school meals. I am currently working with the other local schools to source another provider of school meals.

An invitation to tender has been produced in consultation with an

independent adviser and we are currently having interested companies visit the school.

Each of the short listed companies will be invited to speak to members of all five schools on Monday 25 June. The hope is that a new company will take over the provision of the school meals from 15 October 2018.

I will keep parents informed of the progress made.

Free School Meals

Following a recent consultation by the DfE there will be a new income threshold for all families receiving or going onto Universal Credits (UC)

From I April 2018 the new Income Threshold has changed to £7,400 net pay per annum (take home pay). This means that more families may be eliqible to claim for this financial help.

In addition to the families receiving the financial help schools will also receive financial help for every successful claim until the child moves on to secondary school.
