

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| 1 | <p>Last week we watched the video of Journey by Aaron Becker.</p> <p>This week you are going to focus on the journey that you will be taking as you move towards being a Year 3.</p> <p>Over the course of the week I would like you to complete the transition booklet so that your new teacher can get to know you.</p> | <p>https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/</p> <p>Week 8 (w/c 15th June)</p> <p>You can spread it out throughout the week as you see fit.</p> <p>You do not have to print the worksheets out, you can write the answers in your exercise book or paper.</p> <p>Please follow the sessions in the correct order.</p> | <p><u>READING</u></p> <p>Send photo of the book your child reads each day from either an online book or a real book. You could also find some reading comprehension activities online to do over the week.</p> <p><u>PHONICS</u></p> <p>You can choose from a variety of phonic activities throughout the week.</p> <p>Phonics play</p> <p>Phonicsbloom.com</p> <p>Make sound/word cards – practise the sounds and words as you would do on phonics play. | 5 | | Recap any areas of Maths this week that you found tricky or recap time. | | <p><u>RE</u></p> <p>Watch the clip that you saw last week about the Sikhs place of worship that is called a Gurdwara. Focus on the Langar.</p> <p>Langar (Punjabi: ਲੰਗਰ) (kitchen), is the term used in Sikhism for the community kitchen in a Gurdwara where a free meal is served to all the visitors no matter who you are.
