Headteacher roll of honour

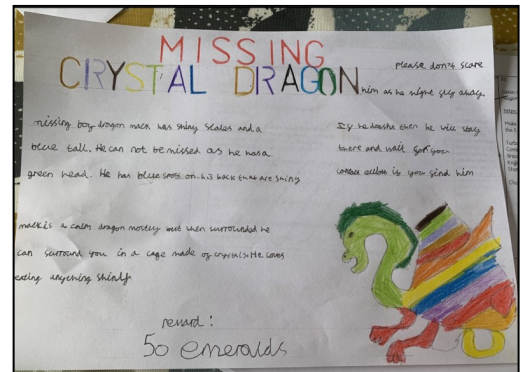
