Dear Parents and Carers,

I am sure you will have heard the government's announcement last night that all schools will be closing at the end of the school day this Friday for the foreseeable future, in order to slow the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19). I just wanted to confirm that this does apply to our school and we will close our doors to Year 2 and Year 6 also.

Due to the unprecedented circumstances with the global pandemic of Coronavirus (COVID-19), we have been asked to remain open for children whose parents are both key workers, the most vulnerable children (including those where there are exceptional circumstances) and those with an Education Health Care Plan and as a school we are committed to doing this.

Importantly, to meet the Key Workers conditions, we do need to know that you have no other suitable childcare i.e. you are a single parent or both parents are key workers in order to access this provision. We have now been provided with a working definition of Key Workers:

- NHS staff
- Teachers and school support staff
- Police and community support officers
- Frontline civilian police staff
- · Prison officers and staff
- Probation officers and trainee probation officers
- LA officers and LA/ NHS social workers
- Uniformed staff in fire and rescue services
- Armed forces personnel and some civilian MOD personnel (ie clinical staff, MOD police, uniformed fire and defence)
- Highway agency traffic staff
- LA environmental health officers/practitioners
- Care workers
- Food/supermarket drivers and other food/supermarket workers
- Those engaged in critical national infrastructure
