What kind of a home do you live in?

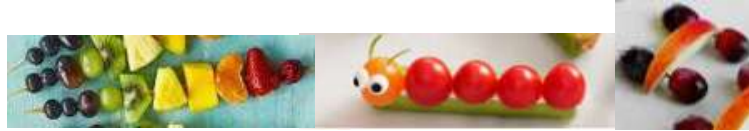
