Big Pedal Initiative

To support the Big Pedal initiative Mr Smith has arranged for representatives from Cambridgeshire Police to come into school to undertake bike or scooter security markings. This is a free service and the marks, whilst discrete in size do make it easier to identify your child's bike or scooter in the event of a theft.

The officers will be on the school site from 3:15pm on Tuesday 26 and Wednesday 27 April 2016.

Bikes and Scooters on the School Playground

Parents and children are reminded that we do not allow bikes or scooters to be ridden whilst on our school premises. We have reminded the children in assemblies this week that they are to dismount from their bikes or scooters at the school gates and should then walk their scooters or bikes round to the storage facilities.

This applies to children of all ages including pre-school children.

The sheer number of people on the playground at the start and end of school means that accidents have happened which can be prevented by the children (and adults) walking their bikes/scooters whilst on the school premises.

Secondary School Transition
