Reading Recovery School of the Year Award

Earlier this week, Mrs Dilley received notification that our school has been awarded; alongside 15 other schools nationally, the award of Reading Recovery School of the Year.

These awards, organised by the International Literacy Centre in London, celebrate and honour practitioners who have made an outstanding contribution to children's literacy through Reading Recovery and have helped to raise standards of literacy in their school.

There will be an awards ceremony on Friday 7 July at the UCL Institute of Education, London where the winning schools will be able to meet the author and poet Pie Corbett as well as the actress Gillian Anderson.
