

Art / Design and Technology

In our art lessons we will be using different techniques to produce weather pictures and models including using clay. We will make observational drawings and use these to produce a fabric collage.

Science

During the first half term we will focus on the weather, seasonal changes and extreme climates and weather. After half term we will be learning all about plants.

Topic

In topic lessons we will be learning about weather maps and symbols, we will use geographical language and collect data about the weather. Later in the term we will find out about the weather in different parts of the world.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be discussing changes and how to manage them. We will also learn about financial capability. Our final topic will be about personal safety.

Seasons and Climate

Music

Our music lessons will focus on pitch, dynamics and timbre using the seasons and climate theme as a stimulus. Later in the term we will use the instruments to produce our own compositions about the weather.

RE

This term we will be learning about the Sikh religion including learning about their beliefs, the symbols used and learning some of the Sikh stories.

PE

In outdoor PE we will be orienteering and developing our athletics skills in preparation for sports day. Indoor PE lessons will focus on gymnastics skills particularly balances and team building activities

Literacy

We will begin the term looking at the text *The Wind Blew* and writing our own narratives. We will write non-chronological reports about the weather. We will write weather poems and explore stories from other cultures.

Maths

This half term we will learn about fractions, effective problem solving methods and position and direction. After half term our work will focus on measures – time, mass, capacity and temperature.

Computing

We will be data handling using different graphing programmes. During the second half term we will be using word processors to produce documents and will learn how to insert pictures.
