Individual School Photographs

Yr 3/4 Trip to Ely and Prickwillow

On Thursday 3 November our Yr3/4went on a trip to the museums at Ely and Prickwillow.

It was a fun filled day that all of the children and adults en joyed. During our time at Ely Museum we learnt about Fen life and the children had a chance to look at the old farm equipment that was used. Whilst at the Prickwillow Drainage Engine we had the chance to meet all of the historical characters that helped to drain the Fenland including Vermuyden. We were also able to try making and testing a flood defence alarm.

Primary School Admissions Process for September 2017

Parents of pre-school children who will be starting at primary school in September 2017 are advised that the application process for school places will open on Wednesday 16 November and will close on Sunday 15 January. This is a national process and the dates are agreed by all the Local Authorities. This year there is an important change:

- parent's apply on time, and will hear on Thursday 18 April 2017, or
- parents apply late ie Monday 16 January until Monday I May 2017 and will not hear until Friday 19 May 2017.

Please note that there is no right of automatic transfer from nursery/preschool to a primary school.

All parents are required to apply for a school place – no places are allocated automatically.

Open Morning and Afternoon to support the Admissions to Primary School Process

We will be holding an Open Morning on Tuesday 22 November and Open Afternoon on Thursday 24 November for parents who have children who will be transferring to primary school in September 2017.

Details of these two sessions will be sent to Paintbox and Butterflies Pre-schools but if your child attends a different pre-school please contact the school office to arrange for the details to be sent directly to you.

Sickness Bugs and Diarrhoea

Unfortunately, we sometimes have children off school with sickness and diarrhoea. In order to contain these germs that quickly spread around a close knit community, we ask parents to keep their children off school for a full 48hrs after the last bout of illness.
