Comic Relief is on the horizon and here at Sutton Primary School we are celebrating it in a couple of different ways. Comic Relief will be taking place on Friday 24 March.

We have decided to embrace all things 'Comic Relief' this year.

Firstly we have purchased some red noses which we will be selling at school in the lead up to the actual day. They will go sale from Monday 13 March 2017. These will be available on the courtyard before and after school and will cost £1.00.

For the actual day itself, pupils can dress up in red rather than coming to school in their school uniform. For example, they might decide to wear a red pair of trousers that they have, or a red jumper.

Alternatively, they could carry on the theme of the actual red noses and dress up as one of the noses using their face as the template. The full list of characters are as follows: Nose-it-all, the all-knowing owl; the Viking Norse Nose; Snootankhamun from ancient Sneezegypt; Snuffles the dragon; DJ Boogie; Dr. Nose; The Snorcerer; Sneezecake the chef; Sniffer the dog and the rarest and scariest Nose of all, Frankinose! It would be possible to do a combination of the two and dress up in red **and** come as your favourite nose. All we ask for in return is a £1.00 donation which will go towards Comic Relief.

Finally as a class project, the children will be creating their own nose design and completing a large version of this to bring into assembly that day. Each class will be judged and the winning class will receive a prize. The class creations will be available to see on the school website.

We really appreciate all the support to the various charities during the current academic year and we hope that this year's Red Nose Day will be a fun day for the children to enjoy.
