Parent Consultations

Safeguarding Issue

If the arrangements for your child at the end of the school day change don't forget to tell the office staff so that we can let your child and their class teacher know.

We have reminded all of the children today that they are to remain close to their class teacher until their parent arrives.

For our older children we have reminded them that if they walk home

on their own and find no one at home they should return to school.

If we haven't heard from you regarding the change of arrangements for your child we cannot let them go with another parent unless we hear from you.

Local Authority Pupil Review

Last Tuesday we had a Local Authority Review and whilst I am yet to receive the formal report the key messages from the report are:

- Pupil Attainment in Maths should still be an area of focus for the school
- Pupils with SEN needs make good progress at the school
- Our targeted higher attaining pupils need to be presented with more challenging work.

Over the coming weeks I shall be working with all the staff at the school to raise the levels of attainment for all our children.

School Dinner Money

If you pay for your child to have a school meal at lunchtime please do be aware that we are unable to allow parents to run a 'tab' system. All meals taken in one week must be paid for before any further meals can be served.

Please make every effort to pay any outstanding balances. If you are

experiencing financial difficulties please do come in and talk to either myself or the office staff as your child may be entitled to free school meals.

School Closure due to bad weather or lack of utility services

Very occasionally I have to take the decision to close the school to the pupils. This may be due to a number of reasons:

- No water where the estimated repair is long and likely to impact on the school day for toilets, handwashing and cooking
- No electricity and the estimated repair is likely to impact on the school day
- No heating
- Bad weather

Primary School Admissions Process for September 2018

Parents of pre-school children who will be starting at primary school in September 2018 are advised that the application process for school places opened on Thursday 16 November and will **close on Monday 15 January 2017**. This is a national process and the dates are agreed by all the Local Authorities.

Please note that there is no right of automatic transfer from nursery/preschool to a primary school.

All parents are required to apply for a school place - no places are allocated. automatically.

Parent Workshop – The Bar Model Approach

Last term we ran a couple of Maths Workshops for parents on the Bar Model.

This method is also known as Singapore Maths and has been repeatedly shown to help children particularly when problem solving.

The workshops last term were popular with parents but a few parents came up to me to say that they were unable to attend.

We are running a repeat of the workshops on the followings days in January:

Monday 29 January – this session is suitable for parents of pupils in the FS and KSI

Tuesday 30 January – this session is suitable for parents of pupils in KS2.

Both workshops will run from 9:00am for approximately 45mins. The workshops will be held in Carnelian Class which is by the number square close to the Bellairs entrance.
