

PSHE

This term we will be covering the topic
Managing Risks

We will learn how to evaluate a risk and
be able to describe a positive and
negative consequence of taking a risk.
We will also be able to give an example
of a physical, social and emotional risk.

Maths

This Term the Maths Topics we are focussing on
are:

Multiplication and Division: We will develop our
understanding of mental and written methods by
solving problems. Including introducing the terms
factors, square numbers and prime numbers.

Fractions: We will learn to read, write and compare
fractions using diagrams and models to help us. We
will then learn how to add, subtract and multiply
fractions.

Decimals and Percentages: We will be linking this
learning to fractions and learning how to manipulate
numbers that are not whole.

English

We will be exploring a range of different text
types. These will all be linked to the topic and
children will have opportunities to write poetry,
diaries and adventure stories.

We will be continuing to learn different aspects
of grammar with a particular focus on fronted
adverbials, direct speech and advanced
punctuation.

We will continue to have weekly spellings and
these are tested on a Monday.

In Guided Reading, we will be using a range of
texts to help us to understand the texts we are
reading.

PE

Indoor PE will be a mixture of
gymnastics and dance this Term.

The children will have the
opportunity to learn The Lindy hop.

Outdoor PE will be led by Mr
Baxter, the sports coach, we will be
learning the skills involved in
playing Hockey.

RE

This term we will be learning to
answer the question 'What kind of
King is Jesus?'

War?**

Music

During this term we will be learning a
selection of Easter songs. We will also
being studying music from World War
II as well as performing pieces that we
create.

Art / Design and Technology

During the Spring Term we will be looking
at the work of artists that draw and paint
images of War. We will then learn some of
the techniques they used.

We will also be learning about the food
eaten and recipes used during World War 2.
We will then replicate these and try out some of
the food that was eaten.

Science

Our Science Topics this Term are 'Materials and
their Properties' followed by 'Animals including
Humans'

During the first topic, we will study the three states
of matter and how different materials are changed
by heat or freezing. We will also begin to learn
about chemical reactions and how they can change
materials.

During the second topic, we will focus on how
animals and humans reproduce. This will include
learning about gestational periods of different
animals.

Topic

During Topic this term we are trying to answer the
question 'What can we learn from War?'

During the term we will mainly focus on World War II
as a significant time period after 1066.

Over the course of the topic we will investigate the
impact of war on Britain and cover things such as
rationing, evacuees, The Holocaust, Dunkirk, The
Blitz.

In the past, children have been really enthusiastic about
learning about the different aspects of World War II. If
you have anything you would like to bring in or stories
from people we would very much like to hear about
them.

Computing

This term we will be continuing to learn
how to stay safe online and what we should
do if we see something that makes us feel
uncomfortable.

We will also be using a range of
programmes to present information, such as
PowerPoint, Word and Publisher.

We will also be using the website
Timestable Rockstars to help learn the quick
recall of the timestables. This is something
the children are encouraged to use at home.
