Art/ Design Technology

We will be learning about David Hockney and how to create the colour brown. We will then move on to pattern making, house painting and making wall paper using those skills and printing skills from last term. After that we will be designing, building and evaluating a house.

PSHE

We will be learning about working together and staying safe. With particular emphasis on what we are good at as individuals and then as a team. We will also be thinking about how safety and behaviour are linked and being aspirational in goal setting. We will also be continuing to explore bullying.

RE

What is the good news Jesus bring? This is our key question this term along with learning about Easter and what that means for Christians. Through RE we will be exploring the bible stories and unpicking the messages that they carry. We will also be linking that to peace and forgiveness.

Trip

This term we will be doing a topic based trip and going on a walk around the village looking at the range of houses in our own environment.

Science

We will be continuing to learn about materials, how they change and their properties. We will also be learning about Spring and what plants need to sustain life. We will be doing lots of practical Science.



Local Study- Houses and Homes

English

We will begin the term with the Fenland Tale of the Buried Moon along with other Fenland tales and songs.

We will then move on to look at learning about Instructions using The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch. After that we will be learning about labels, lists and captions and building that into a recount of our trip. We will then finish the term with a poetry unit build around 'This is the house that Jack built.'

Maths

We will continue to build on the children's knowledge of number and place value.

We will introduce multiplication and division using a variety of strategies. Gathering and interpreting data is another area of focus through investigative Maths. We will also be learning about the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

We will carry out teacher assessments towards the end of the first half term,

Topic

We will be building our learning around Sutton. Where it is; what it is like; the houses here and how it has changed over time. We will be unpicking the history of some of the buildings as well as looking as the materials used for different parts of the houses.

PΕ

The focus for Indoor PE this term will be Gymnastics- travelling and stopping and dancing in a parade style routine.

The Outdoor PE focus will be throwing and catching and game skills involving both of those skills.

Music

We will be focusing our learning on sound walks around our school and how music is used to express different aspects of our daily life. We will also be looking at the materials instruments are made from and how they generate sound.

Computing

We will be learning about e-safety and programming using algorithms.
