#### **Outcomes**

Year 1 Phonics Check

4 Year 1 children completed the Year 1 Phonics Check.

75% of the children passed their Year 1 Phonics Check.

The one child who did not reach the expected standard on the test made good progress throughout the year when the children were tested on their progress.

1 child retook the Phonics Screening Check as a Year 2 but wasn't present during the testing week but had reached 'expected standard' when tested in March.

## End of Key Stage 1 achievement

9 children completed the end of Key Stage 1 tests.

78% reached the expected standard in Reading.

22% achieved greater depth in Reading.

67% reached the expected standard in Writing.

11% achieved greater depth in Writing

89% reached the expected standard in Maths.

33% achieved greater depth in Maths

56% reached the expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths.

11% achieved greater depth in Reading, Writing & Maths.

### End of Key Stage 2 achievement

9 children completed the end of Key Stage 2 tests.

55% reached the expected standard in Reading.

44% reached the expected standard in Writing.

44% reached the expected standard in Maths.

33% reached the expected standard in Reading, Writing & Maths.

44% reached the expected standard in Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling

11% achieved greater depth in Reading & Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling
