Re: The Big Pedal

Our school's Travel Plan which has a key aim of encouraging children to walk, cycle or scooter to school, is constantly evolving and a new initiative we are running this term is called 'The Big Pedal'.

The Big Pedal initiative will be taking place across the next two weeks, 18 – 29 April. The aim of this is to increase the number of children cycling or using a scooter to come to school. We will be inputting the data on a daily basis which will be shared with the pupils. We are also able to include in our 'count' school staff, parents, carers and younger siblings who are not at school to increase our daily totals. There is the potential for the school to win stunt shows, equipment and storage facilities through daily prize draws if just 15% of the school cycle or scoot to school. That is approximately 50 children in our school, not even including all of the supporters.

It is really simple to get involved; all you need to do is plan to cycle or scoot to school as many times as you can during the two week period. The only thing we ask is that if you could please get your children to tell their class teachers that their parent or accompanying adult cycled with them so that these numbers are added to our grand total.

Remember the more people travelling by two wheels, the greater our chances of winning some prizes.
