# KS2 SATs

Next week, alongside their peers around the country our Yr 6 pupils will be assessed using the national end of KS2 SATs tests.

The tests have an agreed format with specific tests timetabled for specific days:

Monday 14 May - Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation Tuesday 15 May – Reading Wednesday 16 May – Maths Paper 1 and Maths Paper 2 Thursday 17 May – Maths Paper 3

These tests will be taking place in the 60's block. Parents are politely asked to leave the school site promptly next week to enable the children to have a calm and quiet environment in which to do their tests.

### FOSS Events

Over the past couple of weeks there have been several FOSS Events held.

## Art Week – week beginning Monday 21 May

We are all beginning to look forward to our annual Art Week which will be held during the week beginning Monday 21 May.

This year our theme will be People. During the week the children will have the opportunity to learn about the following artists and create 'people' using a variety of media:

Monday 21 May - LS Lowry

Tuesday 22 May – Barbara Hepworth

Wednesday 23 May – Weaving as a creative media

Thursday 24 May – Looking at drawing and painting portraits with local artist Kevin Moore

There are some resources that we are hoping the children can bring in from home for Art Week. These include:

- A small single use plastic bottle with a small drinking top
- Odd balls of wool for our weaving activity on Wednesday
- A large shirt that can act as an art apron to protect their school uniforms

There will be opportunities for parents to come into school and get involved with the various activities eg on Tuesday 22 May during our study of the work of the artist Barbar Hepworth the children will be working with their buddies or in small groups to great a series of bumps and curves like those of the Barbapapas. This will involve working with balloons and plaster of paris and we'll need help with the blowing up of the balloons and the pouring of the plaster of paris.

We are hoping for some parents to get involved with the activities. If you'd like to join us for Art Week please go directly to your child's class teacher or email the school office.

#### Sun Cream

With the arrival of the warmer weather we would like to take this opportunity to remind parents that we encourage the children to come into school each day with their sun hats (named) and a water bottle.

Sun protection cream should be applied before school. Children are able to bring their own bottle of sun protection cream into school (ensuring that the bottle is clearly named) and this can be re-applied by the child at lunchtime. It's helpful if you can show your child how to apply the sun cream as some of our children are very heavy handed and end up applying nearly a whole bottle in one application.

Please do remind your child that they should not be sharing their sun cream with other children.

### School Meals

Many of you may have heard that the contractor the school uses to provide our school meals, CCS Catering will cease trading at the end of the calendar year.

Our school is one of five schools within the WASP Partnership to use CCS Catering for the supply of school meals. I am currently working with the other local schools to source another provider of school meals.

An invitation to tender has been produced in consultation with an independent adviser and we are currently having interested companies visit the school.

Each of the short listed companies will be invited to speak to members of all five schools on Monday 25 June. The hope is that a new company will take over the provision of the school meals from 15 October 2018.

I will keep parents informed of the progress made.

#### Yr 4 Swimming

Our Yr 4 children are currently going to The Ivo swimming pool in St Ives for some swimming lessons.

Whilst they are at the pool our Yr 3 children are en joying being taught tennis by a qualified tennis coach. Parents of Yr 3 children are reminded that their children should come to school in their PE kit on Monday mornings to ensure they have the maximum time with the tennis coach.

These sports sessions will continue for the rest of this term.

### Football Coaching

Our Yr 3/4 pupils are also receiving coaching from a qualified football coach from the FA at the moment. This coaching is being funded by the FA as part of their campaign to get involved in sport at the grass roots.

The training will last until the end of this half term.

### Yr 3/4 Sports Festivals

On Friday 4 May a group of eighteen Yr 3/4 pupils went to Witchford Village College for a Tri-Golf and Tennis Tournament.

A team of ten pupils were involved in a variety of different golf games, during these games they were able to use a range of skills and showed great team work.

We also took two teams of four pupils to play tennis as part of a tennis festival.

It was a very successful and sunny event, which all of the participating pupils enjoyed.
