### Individual School Photographs

The majority of our Yr 6 pupils will be undertaking the Bikeability course in January 2016, but in the meantime we shall be reminding the children about the behaviour we are expecting to see and the parents spoken to if any pupil's behaviour continues to cause concern.

- Coping with a particular family issues
- Managing finances

#### Parent Consultations

The Parent Consultation that was postponed due to the school closure last week will now be held on **Thursday IO November 2016**. The appointments that were made for the postponed date will be carried across to the rescheduled day.

There is also one further opportunity this term for parents to meet with their child's class teacher on Thursday 17 November 5:30 – 7:30pm

You can make appointments for these consultations by contacting the school office.

All appointments are 10 minutes in length. It is not necessary for parents to attend every consultation held during the year.

Please note appointments cannot be made on the day of the consultation; this allows staff time to prepare for this event.

### Primary School Admissions Process for September 2017

Parents of pre-school children who will be starting at primary school in September 2017 are advised that the application process for school places will open on Wednesday 16 November and will close on Sunday 15 January. This is a national process and the dates are agreed by all the Local Authorities.

This year there is an important change:

- parent's apply on time, and will hear on Thursday 18 April 2017, or
- they apply late ie Monday I6 January until Monday I May 2017 and will not hear until Friday19 May 2017.

Please note that there is no right of automatic transfer from nursery/pre-school to a primary school.

All parents must apply.

## Open Morning and Afternoon to support the Admissions to Primary School Process

We will be holding an Open Morning on Tuesday 22 November and Open Afternoon on Thursday 24 November for parents who have children who will be transferring to primary school in September 2017.

Details of these two sessions will be sent to Paintbox and Butterflies Pre-schools but if your child attends a different pre-school please contact the school office to arrange for the details to be sent directly to you.

Yr 5 Trip to Ely Fire Station

At the end of last half term our Yr 5 pupils participated in a series of workshops designed to raise the children's awareness of different risks that they may face as they grow older and become more independent. These included: Fire Safety including a mock simulation of evacuating a house fire Electrical Safety including not playing around sub-stations Water Safety Railway Safety including how to use level crossings Basic First Aid

The children were praised by the different groups of volunteers for their listening skills and prior knowledge about a number of different situations.

## School Uniform Orders

With the number of children on roll at our school growing it is becoming increasingly difficult to hold stock of school uniform in school.

With this in mind we will no longer hold uniform in school but will place an order once a month with Brigade (our uniform provider). The cut-off date for parents to order uniform via the school will be the 19<sup>th</sup> day of each month. Orders should then be in school two to three weeks after this date.

If you would like to try uniform on to check for sizing we will hold one item of each size in stock to enable you to do this.
