School Success

I have received a letter from the Local Authority congratulating the school on the end of KS2 SATs results last year (July 2015). The letter noted that the Level 4+ results in reading, writing and maths were the best they have been for the past 4 years.

It was also acknowledged that the progress the children made from the end of KS1 to the end of KS2 was above average in reading and writing with 98% of pupils making two levels of progress. In maths the progress was in line with national at 88%.

It's lovely to have the hard work of the pupils, staff and school community recognised in this way.

Sickness Bug

We do have a number of coughs and colds going round at the moment as well as a sickness bug.

We follow the NHS guidelines which recommends that a full 48hrs should be allowed before a child returns to school after their last bout of illness.

During Parent Consultations we leave our playground gates open so that parents can enter the school easily. During the evening consultations, for safety we only have the main doors open. Parents are therefore requested to use the following doors when they come along:

Ruby, Sapphire and Jade classes — the door to the left of the picnic benches as you look at them.

Amethyst class — the door to the main office then turn left.

Emerald, Amber, Topaz and Turquoise classes

— the door to the main corridor.

Zircon, Carnelian and Citrine classes — the door to the 60's block that opens onto the

courtyard part of the playground (near to Zircon class).

Aquamarine and Tanzanite classes — the mobile classroom's main entrance.

Parents of our Yr 6 pupils are reminded that the deadline for applying for secondary school places is 31 October 2015. This process can be undertaken online, or by asking the office for a paper application form. With school places at a premium it is vital that parents complete the application form. Failure to do so may result in your child not having a place at your preferred school or indeed their catchment school.

Applications received after 31 October 2015 will be considered late and will not receive an offer letter until 20 April 2015.
