

Mathematical Development

We will start the half term learning about numbers from 0 to 10. This will include recognising numerals (0 – 9), counting aloud (up to 10 objects from a larger group), counting objects or actions which cannot be moved and counting irregular arrangements of up to 10 objects.

We will also be learning about measures. We will practise ordering two or three items by length, height, weight and capacity.

Personal Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning about some of the things needed to have a healthy body.

We will be talking about what being healthy means and explaining that our bodies need sleep, exercise and food to keep them healthy.

Communication, Language and Literacy Development

During our Literacy lessons we will be listening to and reading stories, information books and poems about superheroes.

We will be continuing to practise writing our letters correctly and using our phonic knowledge to write words.

We are going to be learning about the difference between capital letters and lower case letters and when capital letters are used.

We will be designing posters to encourage people to look after the environment and we will be learning about how to use finger spaces when writing captions.

Physical Development
