FOSS Events

Over the next couple of weeks there are several FOSS fundraising events:

On Saturday 28 April 2018, Iron Fist have kindly agreed to play a gig in aid of FOSS. The gig is being held at The Brooklands Centre next to the school. Doors open at 7:30pm. Tickets are selling fast... they will be on sale this week from members of the FOSS Committee who will be on the playground at the end of the school day.

Tickets cost £8.

Parents are reminded that this event is not open to children.

If you can't get into school at the end of the school day but would like to support FOSS please send your ticket money into the school office and they will arrange for the ticket(s) to be sent home with your child.

On Friday 27 April we will be holding a Mufti-Day in aid of the school summer fete. The children may come to school in their own clothes but, rather than paying £1.00 we are asking them to bring into school something that can be used/sold at the school's summer fete which is being held on Saturday 9 June 2018.

Items that FOSS are looking for include:

- cans of either food or drink
- unwanted gifts

FOSS have considerable amounts of books and children's toys and will not be able to accept any of these as donated items.

On Wednesday 2 May FOSS will be hosting a Cake Break. This term they are raising funds to build a footpath up to our outdoor classroom to help make this resource accessible all year round. Parents of pupils in the FS and KSI are asked to bake cakes for the sale.

Each cake will be sold for 30p.

Yr I Parents - Phonics Workshop

Times Tables Rock Stars - Key Stage 2

Hopefully your child/children came home with their 'Times Tables Rockstars' log-in before the end of the Spring Term? This is a great, interactive way for your child to learn their times tables especially with the raised expectation in the National Curriculum of pupils needing to know all their times tables up to 12 x 12 by the end of Year 4.

If you haven't received the log-in, or it got lost amongst the multitude of Easter Eggs over the holidays, please speak to your child's class teacher first and foremost.

The activity is primarily web-based but some of the classes will be working through some of their times tables at school through good old fashioned pencil and paper too so any practice that can be done at home would be fantastic.

If you have a compatible smart phone, there is an app available to download which would make it easier for your child to access their account.

This resource has been recommended to us by another school and has had positive results in helping their pupils to learn their times tables.

Sun Cream

With the arrival of the warmer weather we would like to take this opportunity to remind parents that children should come into school each day with their sun hats (named) and a water bottle.

Sun protection cream should be applied before school. Children are able to bring their own bottle of sun protection cream into school (ensuring that the bottle is clearly named) and this can be re-applied by the child at lunchtime. It's helpful if you can show your child how to apply the sun cream as some of our children are very heavy handed and end up applying nearly a whole bottle in one application. Please do remind your child that they should not be sharing their sun cream with other children.
